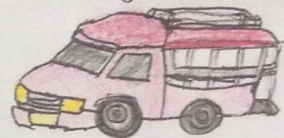

Motorcycle 150-200 bath/day for a Honda Wave (125cc)

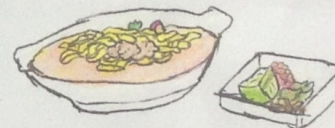


Local Bus Minimum fair is ฿15

Wat Phra That Doi Kong Mu

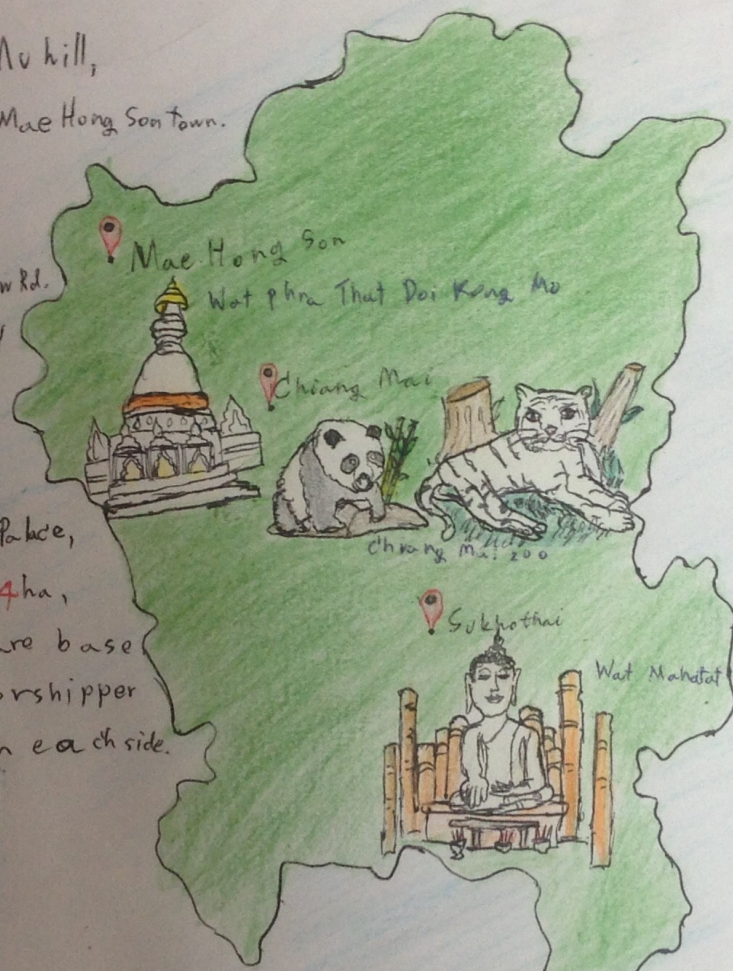
The temple is located on top of Doi Kong Mu hill, almost 1km west of Chom Kham Lake and Mae Hong Son town. Two paths lead up the 250 meter high hill.

Chiang Mai Zoo and Aquarium

is a 200-acre (81 ha) zoo on Huay Kaew Rd. Overall, 400 animal species are represent in the zoo.

Wat Mahathat

This temple was near the earlier Royal Palace, and this temple alone covered an area of 4 ha, surrounded by 189 chedis. The high square base is decorated by a procession of worshipping with 40 figures of about 1m high on each side.

Yee Peng

In the Chiang Mai celebration is known as Yee Peng. The festival features beautifully illuminated lanterns, which are either carried, displayed houses and temple, even launched in to the night sky.
